Subject: Thomson Reuter CLEAR services

Thomson Reuters CLEAR Provides a comprehensive, online investigative platform that allows investigators and analysts to easily access billions of public records, publicly available information, and proprietary data for investigation and due diligence, including identity verification and risk assessment, screening, and monitoring. We have been using their services to proactively protect the citizens for the past 4 years and have recently worked with them to add services to our new contract. Our current contract ended on April 1, 2024 and we have not been able to renew.

Given that we are in arrears by four months, the services are in jeopardy of being suspended, which would impact BPD's Watch Center and their ability to function. Since funding for all services has been identified, payment for the past four months and the next four months is needed while we are seeking board approval for the new contract. In total we are requesting \$93,930.00 which would cover the past due payments and three months to get Board approval. General Funds will be used to pay this vendor.
